President Monte Monroe's Swan Song

This was the last club meeting that 2009-2010 President Monte Monroe officiated. President Monroe inducted two new members to the club: Dr. Paul Anderson, incoming Governor for District 5730, who just recently moved to Wolfforth, as well as Garrett Morgan, sponsored by Alice White.

During his main presentation, Monte pointed out a photograph from 1936 that depicted the members of the Rotary Club of Lubbock of that time, many of them legendary business and community icons of the Lubbock area. As part of his farewell speech, President Monroe expressed his deep appreciation for all Board members, club officers, directors, past presidents and committee chairs who had worked tirelessly for the good of the community.

Among others, Monte highlighted the Golf Tournament Committee, led by Chris Lane, that raised over \$30,000 additional funds for the South Plains Food Bank; the highly active Student Scholarship Committee by Greg Moore, that awarded several scholarships to well-deserving young adults; the Adoption Carnival, chaired by Gary McCoy, that successfully brought together eligible children and prospective adoptive parents for the second year; and the Toast Committee that hosted the appreciation programs for several Rotary members with decades of service to the club. President Monroe was particularly grateful for Program Chair Charles Key, who raised the bar in programs and speakers. Monte presented Executive Director Marjan Wilkins with a small gift of appreciation for her diligent hard work on the daily operations of the club.

Past President Davis Armistead then installed the new Board members and club officers, and confirmed the existing ones – “Let’s not hesitate [to step forward]!” Laura Monroe affixed The Past President’s Pin to Monte Monroe, with a side story passed on about past president Ray Diekemper who showed up without it one day, only to realize that he must have left it on his pajamas. Now-past President Monte Monroe received a standing ovation from the audience.

Dr. Armistead then introduced the new President for 2010-2011: He passed the gavel to Ann Graham – the very first female president in 89 years of club history! With the help of her family, President Ann received the President’s pin and badge from Dr. Armistead. Ann will enlighten us about the club goals for the new Rotary year at the 7/21 meeting. With that, new President Ann Graham adjourned the meeting promptly at 1:00pm, true to Rotary tradition.
